Email:

Emails are sent using the website services of a third party provider, with the email addresses of the recipients hidden when emails are sent. In addition to a large number of recreational boaters, the Press, OC Dana Point Harbor (department), Harbor Merchants, Marine Services, Political Organizations, Contractors, and Government Officials are on the email address list. The current lists are maintained and stored on a secure server website service. The Association does not make the email lists or email addresses available to anyone, except as provided by California Corporate Law.

SaveOurHarbor Blog:

The SaveOurHarbor Blog is an open public community, open to all interested parties. We know that in addition to boaters, a large number of non-boaters may be subscribed. When you join SaveOurHarbor Blog any details that you've entered for your profile, your email address, and your User ID will be visible to others. When you post, send or reply to a Blog your User ID/email address may be visible to all recipients, depending on how your account is set up.

Surveys:

Surveys are electronically collected by a third party that is under contract with the Association. Association Officers are responsible for maintaining surveys and the interfaces to the web service company. We typically prepare and publish summarized data and may also disclose editorial comments provided by survey takers, without disclosing the source. We do not disclose any personal information. Contact details, offers of assistance, suggestions, recommendations and requests for information may be known to the Board of Directors and Committee Chairs.

Membership Roster:

The Association's roster is kept strictly confidential with all information being controlled on a "need to know" basis. The Association does not make the membership roster available to anyone other than Board members and Committee Chairs, except as provided by California Corporate Law.
