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## **RESOLUTION NO. 06-01**

## RESOLUTION OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF ORANGE COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

January 10, 2006

On Motion of Commissioner Wooden, duly seconded and carried, the following Resolution was adopted:

WHEREAS, the County of Orange ("County")has prepared a Revitalization Plan for Dana Point Harbor ("Project") which will establish a Commercial Core and provide for the replacement and/or remodeling of all existing retail and restaurant buildings, and allow for the future expansion of other Harbor facilities and the ongoing maintenance and operation of the entire Harbor facility;

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors of Orange County adopted Resolution No. 88-316 approving the incorporation of the City of Dana Point on March 8, 1988; and

WHEREAS, Dana Point Harbor is entirely located within the City of Dana Point; and

WHEREAS, on October 29, 2003, the County is lead agency under the California Environmental Quality Act ("CEQA") issued a Notice of Preparation ("NOP") for the Dana Point Harbor Revitalization Plan Program Environmental Impact Report No. 591 and caused the NOP to be distributed to all responsible agencies, trustee agencies and interested parties for review and comment; and

WHEREAS, the County, in an effort to provide further opportunity for public review and commentary relative to the Dana Point Harbor Revitalization Plan and the Draft Program EIR No. 591, conducted a public open house on June 7, 2005; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the NOP for the Dana Point Harbor Revitalization Plan Program Environmental Impact Report No.591, and in recognition of the comments received in response to the NOP, the County determined that the Project may result in significant adverse effects and therefore prepared Draft Program Environmental Impact Report No. 591 (State Clearinghouse Number SCH No. 2003101142), dated September 27, 2005(the "Draft Program EIR"); and

WHEREAS, a Notice of Completion for the Draft Program EIR 591 was filed on September 27, 2005 giving public notice of the availability of the Draft Program EIR for review and comment; and

WHEREAS, copies of the Draft Program EIR 591 were circulated and made available for public review and comment between September 27, 2005 and November 10, 2005 (the "Comment Period"); and

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WHEREAS, in furtherance of CEQA's<sup>1</sup> goal of promoting public participation in the environmental review process, the Orange County Planning Commission ("Planning Commission") conducted a public workshop on December 7, 2005 to address the Revitalization Plan and Draft Program EIR 591 and to solicit public comments thereon; and

WHEREAS, during the Comment Period, more than 17 comments were received relative to the Draft Program EIR 591; and

WHEREAS, in accordance with the requirements of CEQA, responses to those comments were prepared, and said comments and responses were provided to the Planning Commission in a separate document entitled "Program Environmental Impact Report No. 591 Responses to Comments" ("Responses to Comments"); and

WHEREAS, the proposed Final Program EIR 591 will be comprised of (i) the Draft Program EIR 591, (ii) a list of persons, organizations and public agencies commenting on the Draft Program EIR, (iii) comments received from the public and interested agencies, (iv) the Responses to Comments, (v) revisions to the text of the Draft Program EIR 591 reflecting changes made in response to comments and other information, (vi) other changes to the text of the Draft Program EIR 591, and (vii) all attachments and documents incorporated by reference into the Program EIR 591; and

WHEREAS, Section 9 in the Statement of Findings and Facts, lists the Statement of Overriding Considerations and Section 9.2 of that section also lists the Unavoidable Adverse Significant Impacts of the Project.

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission has reviewed the findings contained in the "Statement of Findings and Facts in Support of Findings" with respect to significant impacts identified in the Final Program EIR 591. The Statement of Findings is attached hereto as <a href="Exhibit A">Exhibit A</a> and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, a Mitigation Monitoring and Reporting Program ("MMRP") has been drafted to meet the requirements of CEQA Section 21081.6 as a mitigation measure monitoring program. The MMRP is designed to ensure compliance with the mitigation measures imposed upon the Project to avoid or substantially lessen the significant effects identified in the Final Program EIR 591; and

WHEREAS, a copy of the MMRP is attached hereto as <u>Exhibit B</u> and incorporated herein by this reference; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Commission finds that the Final Program EIR 591identifies all significant environmental effects of the Project, and that there are no known potential environmental impacts which are not specifically and adequately addressed in the Final EIR 591; and

WHEREAS, The Planning Commission finds that although the Final Program EIR 591 identifies certain significant environmental effects that will result if the Project is approved, those significant effects which can be feasibly mitigated or avoided have been reduced to an acceptable level by the incorporation of project design features ("PDFs"), standard conditions of approval ("SCAs") and requirements, and by the imposition of mitigation measures ("MMs") on the approved Project. The individual PDFs, SCAs and mitigation measures identified for the Project are incorporated into the Statement of Findings (see (Exhibit A) as part of the MMRP (see Exhibit B); and

WHEREAS, the Planning Commission reviewed all documentation and materials comprising the Final Program EIR and found that the Final Program EIR 591 considers all environmental effects of the Recommended Project and is complete and adequate and fully complies with all requirements of CEQA and CEQA Guidelines; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, the Planning Commission hereby makes the following recommendation:

The Planning Commission recommends certification of Final Program EIR 591 as complete and adequate in that it addresses all environmental effects of the Project and fully complies with the requirements of CEQA, the CEQA Guidelines and the County's environmental analysis procedures. All of the information comprising the Final Program EIR 591 is on file with the County of Orange -Dana Point Harbor Department, 24650 Dana Point Harbor Drive, Dana Point, California.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED: that the Orange County Planning Commission hereby adopts Planning Commission Resolution 06-01 recommending certification of Final EIR 591.
