FOURTH OF JULY 2018 IMPORTANT INFORMATION



July 4th is the busiest day of the year in Dana Point Harbor . With the holiday falling on a Wednesday this year we anticipate a busy weekend leading up to the holiday. That said, parking resources will likely begin to fill up starting Saturday night and reach near capacity by Tuesday late afternoon. Parking is reserved for Dana West Marina boaters only on July 4th but the lots will still fill to capacity very early. **Showing up with a vehicle on Wednesday, July 4th after 10 AM is not recommended.** It is highly likely that there will be no parking available and you will be turned away. In an effort to help you better prepare for spending the holiday in the Harbor, please keep in mind the following important information:

- ◆ An assigned marina access card or fob **AND** a valid Dana West Marina parking sticker will be required for parking lot entry. If you do not have **BOTH** of these, you will not be admitted. **STICKER MUST BE ADHERED TO THE VEHICLE TO BE PERMITTED.**
- ◆ In addition to the above, Marina staff will be at the parking gate with a roster listing only current marina Boat Slip Licensees. **If you have both an access card & parking sticker but your name is not on the roster; you will not be admitted into the parking lot.**
- ◆ We encourage you to carpool. **A MAXIMUM OF TWO VEHICLES PER ASSIGNED BOAT SLIP WILL BE ALLOWED ENTRY INTO THE BOATER PARKING LOT PROVIDED THERE IS AVAILABLE PARKING.** Additional vehicles will be directed to park at Dana Hills High School and use the shuttle. There will be no exceptions.
- ◆ **GUESTS WILL NOT BE PERMITTED TO PARK IN THE BOATER PARKING LOTS ON JULY 4TH.** Please direct your guests to park at Dana Hills High School and use the shuttle. There will be no exceptions.
- ◆ Arrive early and stay put. We anticipate parking will fill up completely by mid-morning on July 4th. **THE PARKING LOTS WILL BE CLOSED TO EVERYONE ONCE THEY ARE FILLED TO CAPACITY.**
- ◆ The City of Dana Point will provide free continual shuttle service from 10 AM to 11 PM. The shuttle leaves from Dana Hills High School and drops off at the corner of Golden Lantern and Dana Point Harbor Drive. There will be an intra-Harbor trolley running on a limited route in a continual loop. **We will also have golf cart shuttles and drop off locations outside of each marina parking lot available to assist you and your belongings to the gangway.**
- ◆ **NO VEHICLES WILL BE PERMITTED INTO THE LOT TO DROP OFF SUPPLIES OR EQUIPMENT.**
- ◆ Campers, RVs and trailers are prohibited.
- ◆ Vehicles parked in fire lanes or outside designated spaces are subject to towing.
- ◆ **Parking space saving is not permitted for any reason.**
- ◆ **Giving "your" parking space to a guest or boat neighbor is not permitted. Parking spaces are not yours to give.**
- ◆ Fireworks and BBQs on the docks are a serious fire hazard and violations will be taken seriously.
- ◆ Parking lots and roads into the Harbor will be closed by Dana Point Police Services prior to the fireworks.
- ◆ **All left hand turn lanes in the Harbor will be closed off. This traffic arrangement may require you to pass your desired entrance and come back around. Be patient.**
- ◆ Please, no water balloons; they can be harmful to birds and marine life.
- ◆ **No bands or amplified sound will be tolerated on the docks or on vessels docked in the marina.**
- ◆ Remember that all marina Rules and Regulations apply on the holiday. Please be respectful to your neighbors and marina staff.

We will have marina staff at the parking gates leading up to July 4th. We ask that you please be kind and courteous to our staff and allow them to guide you to the nearest available parking spaces or options. If you arrive after 10 AM on July 4th, please be prepared to be redirected by our friendly staff. **Please keep in mind that your Boat Slip License does not guarantee you a parking space.** Please plan to take advantage of the shuttle service if you are coming late. See shuttle route on the reverse side of this page. If you are having a party on your boat on the 4th; please direct your invited guests to use the shuttle service. **NO GUEST PARKING WILL BE ALLOWED ON JULY 4th.** Please call the marina office with any questions or concerns.

Summer is right around the corner. With that in mind, we continue to keep busy with maintenance and improvements in preparation for the busy boating season. Our boat slips are nearly all filled up which means big crowds are anticipated from Memorial Day through Labor Day as folks enjoy their boats and the harbor. I ask that you please help us and your fellow boat neighbors by returning dock carts to the bottom of the gangway after use. We do our best to keep the dock carts evenly distributed on each dock so they are available for your convenience. We notice more and more carts seem to be "walking away". We try our best to track them down and retrieve them but we don't always catch them before they disappear completely. If we all put effort into keeping the dock carts safe and secure behind the locked gates, there is a far better chance that a cart will be available when you need it. If you use a cart to transport provisions from your vehicle to your boat, please bring the cart back to the foot of the gangway when you are done. If you use a cart to unload your boat and bring supplies to your vehicle, please put the extra effort into walking the cart back down to the bottom of the gangway. We plan to roll out several new dock carts between now and July 4th. We appreciate your assistance in keeping the dock carts clean and accessible to all boaters.

We are excited to announce that we installed a new convenient payment system for laundry that doesn't require quarters. Boaters can now pay for laundry with their phones using the PayRange app. No quarters needed and there are no extra fees. It's simple, fast and secure. Just download the PayRange app and connect with washers and dryers in our boater laundry rooms. Not only does the app allow you to load funds and pay, it also keeps track of the time remaining on the laundry cycle.

Restroom improvements and dock repair remain our primary focus. E-Building restroom improvements are complete and look wonderful. Take a look and let us know what you think.
