## Clean Marina Certification

We are proud to announce that the Dana Point Marina Company once again received recognition as a “Clean Marina” by the Marina Recreational Association. The program is a partnership of private and government marina operators dedicated to providing clean facilities to the boating community and protecting the State’s waterways. To obtain the Clean Marina Certification, a marina facility must create a comprehensive plan for environmental protection, covering key items such as boater education, waste oil recycling, litter removal, spill preparedness, etc. In addition, the program provides a network of marina operators to share new ideas to protect the environment.

## Marina Reminders

- Refueling at dock side is considered a high risk fire hazard and is prohibited.
- You may not perform engine overhauls at the dock.
- Fishing or swimming within the Marina, including fishing from boats are not permitted.
- Please keep the dock gate locked at all times. This is for your protection.
- Do not store or place anything near piling rollers. Pile rollers are constantly in motion due to tides and items can be caught in the rollers, causing a serious hazard and damaging the dock at your expense.
- Please stay off the harbor seawalls, they are extremely slippery and dangerous.

Not only does the inspection ensure that your vessel is equipped for safe operation, but it also reduces the chance of a time-consuming “spot” inspection at sea.
