Effective January 1, 2018 the State of California will begin phased in implementation of the new Boater Card. The California Boater Card will show that its holder has successfully taken and passed a NASBLA/state-approved boater safety education examination. Once issued, the card remains valid for a boat operator's lifetime.
