Construction Notice

We have just been notified of plans to install a new natural gas line down the length of Casitas Place, from Dana Point Harbor Drive to the entrance of Marina Parking Gate 2.

The project is planned to begin on 9/11 and last for approximately 35-days. During the project access to Marina lot 2 will be maintained but will likely be reduced to a single lane at times.

Please anticipate possible slight traffic delays during the project.

Oversized Vessels

There have been recent changes to Marina policy regarding the maximum length of vessel allowed in each slip. Although the policy will not be applied to vessels retroactively it does mean that a new vessel of the same length may no longer be acceptable in the same slip and a formerly approved vessel may no longer be acceptable in the same size slip when sold.

Before purchasing a new vessel, make sure you perform an honest measurement of the new vessel from tip-to-tip including all extensions and contact the marina office regarding what is allowed in your assigned slip.
