Dana Point Harbor Maintenance
Dredging Project
Vessels Should Exercise Caution

A maintenance dredging project is anticipated to begin in late December and continue through April, 2016. This project will allow the Harbor to remain open and operational while removing accumulating sediments currently impeding boater navigation and provide for much needed replenishment to some of our local beaches. A more detailed project schedule will be provided as specifics become available. The project will involve the mobilization of dredging equipment and the possible temporary relocation of vessels in specific areas. Boaters and other watercraft users are advised to stay clear of dredging equipment during this time.

Live Aboard Permits

Despite recent rumors to the contrary, the East Basin Marina has live aboard permits immediately available. To qualify, you must occupy a slip 35ft or larger and complete a live aboard permit agreement. Permit fees are equal to 40% of the basic monthly slip fee. Advice from the Manager...

Under the terms of the Slip License, vessel partnerships are acceptable provided the licensee maintains an appropriate ownership interest. **HOWEVER**, such transactions should be conducted **ABOVE BOARD**, in writing, and for appropriate payment. The same goes for corporations. Such vessel ownership is carefully scrutinized.

Marina Rules - For the Environment

- Marina Rule 54 is a compilation of Best Management Practices for protecting the environment while maintaining your boat. Please read them over from time to time.
- Marina Rule 39 prohibits the storage of flammable or hazardous materials in dock boxes at any time.
- Marina Rule 21 limits vessel repairs in the slip to light maintenance at the sole discretion of the Marina.
