VESSEL MAINTENANCE

Please remember that only minor vessel maintenance is allowed at the dock. No welding, spray painting, hull painting, major engine work, or jobs that take more than 7 days to complete or involve more than 20% of the vessel topside. Please check out the marina rules on the marina website.
